

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON RESOLUTION FOR INCLUSION OF PROPERTY INTO STEAMBOAT SPRINGS  
AREA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 15, 2018 the Board of Directors of the Steamboat Springs Area Fire Protection District will hold a public meeting to consider a proposed Resolution Approving Inclusion of Real Property within the City of Steamboat Springs Upon the Affirmative Majority Vote of the Eligible Electors Within the Area to be Included, a proposed Board Order Approving Inclusion of Real Property within the City of Steamboat Springs Upon the Affirmative Majority Vote of the Eligible Electors Within the Area to be Included, and to put the question of said inclusion to the voters at a special election to be held May 7, 2019. The properties proposed for inclusion include all of the territory within the City's corporate boundaries.

The meeting will be held at Centennial Hall, 124 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Rooms 113/114, Steamboat Springs, Colorado 80487.

All interested persons, municipalities, or counties that may be able to provide service to the real properties shall appear at the public meeting and show cause in writing why the Board of Directors of the Steamboat Springs Area Fire Protection District should not adopt a final resolution and order to include said properties and hold a special election on May 7, 2019 regarding the inclusion of the properties into the District. The Board of Directors may continue the public meeting to a subsequent meeting. The failure of any person within the Steamboat Springs Area Fire Protection District to file a written objection shall be taken as an assent on his or her part to the inclusion of the properties into the Steamboat Springs Area Fire Protection District's jurisdiction.
